

# Editorial

It is a great satisfaction to present the 23rd number of *Jahr – European Journal of Bioethics*. The amount and variety of papers have been preserved, but this issue introduces something especially new. A collaboration with the Humanities Research Institute from Chung-Ang University in Seoul, South Korea, has started, and a special section devoted to Artificial Intelligence Humanities has been included in the *Jahr*.

The article about communication problems in cases addressed at clinical ethics conferences opens a general section. Then you can read about parenting style and the active involvement of fathers in child-rearing. Conscientious objection in medicine is a topic of the next contribution, and the one following is devoted to the critical questioning of whether transhumanism is an adequate solution to euthanasia. The following contribution investigates the psychosocial interventions for persons with Alzheimer's dementia and their caregivers, and the last article tries to answer whether Brazilians have made bioethics social.

As already mentioned, the additional space has been given for the publication of two papers in a new section of the *Jahr* – Artificial Intelligence Humanities: first, stressing the bioethical aspects of robotics in surgery, and the second, dealing with transhumanism.

One book review and one scientific meeting review are also a part of this issue.

I would like to thank the members of the Editorial Board, peer reviewers, and all other associates included in the creation of this issue. I owe special thanks to the Executive Editor, Managing Editor, and our Language Editors for their tremendous help, but also special thanks go to our member of Editorial Board Gordana Pelčić for her engagement in motivating authors from International Society for Clinical Bioethics annual conference to prepare and publish their contributions in this issue.
